SPECTATOR COURSE

1. START - ULTRA SIERRA NEVADA 2018

- Location: Paseo del Salón, Granada
- Car Access: possible and easily accessible
- Starts at 00:00
- Description: The Ultra starts in Granada center next to Genil river and shopping streets. The race will start with a sprint until the first hard ascent through Alhambra Palace Hotel.

- 2. INTERESTING & CULTURAL LANDSCAPE
 - Location: Mirador de San Nicolás (Granada)



Car Access: NOT ALLOWED

Travelling time: 25' from Granada

- First runner at 00:15
- Description: The runner will finish the Albaicín ascent and then go through the Darro River, which is born in the Sierra Nevada mountains, before going up to the top of the Alhambra. The runners will be among many musicians and artists in the most visited area in Granada, which boasts the best views of the Alhambra and Sierra Nevada mountains. The Albaicin neighbourhood and the Alhambra monument are considered UNESCO World Heritage sites and are actually denominated as Dobla de Oro.

3. SPECTATOR LOOP & CONTROL POINT 1

- Location: Cross on the mountain pass next to Urbanización Cerro del Sol in Cenes de la Vega.
- Car access: possible & easily accessible
- Traveling time: 20' from the start
- First runner at 1:05
- Description: This will be the first aid station where you can enjoy an awesome panoramic view. Runners can be seen at least 4 times here, forming snake lights. They will come from Llano de la Perdiz, have runner's equipment ready and go to Darro river again.

4. VILLAGE PASS (BEAS DE GRANADA) & CONTROL POINT 2

- Location: Beas de Granada village
- Car access: possible & easily accessible
- Travelling time: 40' from Granada
- First runner at 2:00 and Trail start at 7:00
- Description: Beas de Granada is a municipality in the province of Granada (Andalusia, Spain), located in the eastern part of the Vega de Granada at 1,072 meters of altitude; It is a village of half mountain. The runners will pass through the Town Hall, where they will find CP 2 (refreshment)
- Location: 37.21809, -3.48116

4. VILLAGE PASS (QUENTAR) & CONTROL POINT 4

- Location: Quéntar village
- Car access: possible & easily accessible
- Travelling time: 30' from Granada
- First runner at 4:40 and Maraton start at 8:30
- Description: in the edge of the Sierra de Huétor mountains. Quéntar contains typical mountain narrow streets from the andalusi age. The runners will go next to local government and get the fourth aid station.

5. FUENTE DE LA TEJA & CONTROL POINT 5

Location: Fuente de la Teja



- Car access: possible & easily accessible
- Travelling time: 15' from Güejar Sierra
- First runner at 5:45 and Maraton start at 8:30
- Description: the runners get over the hardest moment, sleepy and tired, thanks for the special sunrise. The begin a spectacular and technical ascent to Calar Alto.
- Location: 37.18009, -3.43147

5. USN SUNRISE

- Location: Collado de la Gitana (pass)
- Car access: possible & easily accessible
- Travelling time: 20' from Güejar Sierra.
- First runner at 6.40
- Description: the runners get over the hardest moment, sleepy and tired, thanks for the special sunrise. The begin a spectacular and technical descent to Güejar Sierra village.
- Location: 37.172841, -3.397619

6. VILLAGE PASS (GÜEJAR SIERRA) & CONTROL POINT 6

- Location: Güejar Sierra village
- Car access: possible and easily accessible
- Travelling time: 30' from Granada
- First runner at 7:20
- Description: the village is situated at norwest of Sierra Nevada National Park, between the Cerro del Calar hill and the Canales water reservoir. Its neighbourhoods conserve the Serrana architecture. The runners cross the village, have provisions and continue to Canales water reservoir
- Location: 37.159696, -3.438970

7. DORNAJO (VIEWS & CONTROL POINT 7)

- Location: Mirador de las Víboras y Barranco del Castillar
- Car Access: possible and easily accessible
- Travelling time: 30' from Granada, 25' from Güejar Sierra and 15' from Pradollano ski resort.
- First runner at 8:25
- Description: You can enjoy a beautiful landscape and a large Ultra & runners panorama. It's situated next to the Dornajo Visitor Center. Extra water point in A-395, Km 23.
- Location: 37.137005, -3.441583

8. HIGH MOUNTAIN LANDSCAPE & FOREST

- Location: Botanical garden and Fuente Fria MTBcircuit
- Car access: possible and easily accessible
- Travelling time: 40' from Granada, 30' from Cenes de la Vega and 5' from Pradollano Ski resort
- First runner at 9:35
- Description: part of the Fuente Fría MTB circuit, gorgeous area of forest and tipycal semidesert terrain of high mountain climate.

9. PASS NEXT TO FINISH AND CONTROL POINT 9

Location: La Cantina restaurant in Pradollano ski resort

Car access: Unpossible, 5' walking from the parking

Travelling time: 45' from Granada

• First runner at 10:20

 Description: the runners can listen to music of the finish area and have provisions. However, there are still more than 10Km: 4Km going up to Veleta top and 6Km going down until finish line in Pradollano. This is almost a vertical kilometer

10. FLYING DOWN THE SKI RESORT

Location: Borreguiles chair lift

Access: we recommend you take the chairlift. Organizers will give you a forfait

Travelling time: 45' from Granada and 5' from finish line

• First runner: 10:20 ->12:00

 Description: we fly over the race seeing the Veleta top ascent and descent during last 2 sections

Location: 37.093470, -3.398917

11. HIGHEST RACE POINT 10

Location: The chairlift Veleta ends

Car access: possible but we recommend you to use the chairlift

Travelling time: 20' lifting

• First runner at 11:05

• Description: this is the chairlift ends, next to Veleta top. Veleta is 3.398m, the third highest top in Iberian Peninsula. Last aid station and medical service taking care of the injured runners.

12. USN2018 FINISH LINE

Location: Pradollano (Ski resort)

Car access: possible and easily accessible

Travelling time: 45' from Granada

• First runner at 11:30

Description:

 Description: after more than 12 hours running, runners will arrive smiling and full of satisfaction because they have completed the incredible challenge of 100Km. Pradollano form part of Monachil town and is visited by international tourists during winter. Also this one of the biggest spanish ski resorts
